The session will involve not only the techniques of preventing and defusing violence at peaceful demonstrations but also the attitudes and commitments that peacekeepers and protesters alike must share. In addition to a professional YouTube presentation from Move On, an experienced Peacekeeper and trainer will share methods for de-escalating potentially violent situations and will provide an opportunity for role-playing practice. People who want to take a leadership role in this type of activity are welcome to pursue more complete training.
